"The Christian Family"

Genesis 2:18; Matthew 19:6; Ephesians 5:22-25; 28, 33; 6:1-2, 4

Minister: And the Lord God said, it is not good that the man should be alone; I will make an help meet for him.

Congregation: Wherefore they are no more twain, but one flesh. What therefore God hath joined together, let not man put asunder.

Minister: Wives, submit yourselves unto your own husbands, as unto the Lord.

Congregation: For the husbands is the head of the wife, even as Christ is the head of the church: and he is the savior of the body.

Minister: Therefore, as the church is subject unto Christ, so let the wives be to their own husbands in everything.

Congregation: Husbands, love your wives, even as Christ also loved the church, and gave himself for it.
